PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Cook County Board of Commissioners that Chapter 34 Finance, Section 34-370 of the Cook County Code is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 34-370. Child Support Compliance a Condition of Continued Employment and Offers of Employment

(a) The County Comptroller shall review the records of the appropriate child support enforcement agent of the State of Illinois IV-D Child Support Enforcement Program (the "IV-D Agent") to determine whether any employee has delinquent child support. The review may occur electronically, and must be performed not less than monthly. If the Comptroller determines that the name and/or address or other pertinent individual data of any County employee appear within the records of the child support enforcement agent, and is indicated therein as delinquent or in arrears, the Comptroller shall notify the appropriate child support enforcement agent of the

current employment status of that County employee. The Comptroller shall comply with all court-ordered wage garnishments pertaining to sums due and owed by employees of the County for child support.

(b) Every person who is given an offer of employment with the County shall file an affidavit with the Bureau of Human Resources disclosing any unpaid court-ordered child support obligations owed by the applicant, and including the court number of their child support case and the county and state in which the child support case is pending.

(c) Where an applicant's affidavit discloses, or the department of human resources otherwise determines, that an applicant owes any unpaid court-ordered child support, such applicant shall only be hired by the County on the condition that he or she establishes one of the following within six months of the start of employment:

(1) the applicant has paid to the obligee all child support due under the court order, as evidenced by a certified court order or official clerk's record that no support is due and owing; or

(2) the applicant has entered into a court-approved agreement for the payment of all child support owed and is in compliance with that agreement; or

(3) the applicant is not an obligor under a court-ordered child support obligation. Failure to establish one of the above criteria within six months of the start of employment shall be grounds for discharge.

(d) In addition, all new and existing County employees must take all steps within their power to ensure that an income withholding notice for any current, ongoing child support obligation has been served upon the County, and amounts are being deducted from their salary or wages in compliance therewith.

(e) All County employees must comply with all court-ordered child support obligations as a condition of employment. Noncompliance shall be grounds for discipline.

(f) The Bureau of Human Resources is authorized to treat administrative child support orders in the same manner as it does court-ordered child support obligations under this section and to promulgate rules and regulations to govern the treatment of such administrative orders. As used herein, "administrative child support orders" are orders or findings by the Illinois Department of Public Aid (or any other state agency authorized by statute to so act in its stead), pursuant to Article X of the Illinois Public Aid Code, 305 ILCS 5/10-1 to 1-022, or any similar statute, imposing child support payment obligations.

(g) The Bureau of Human Resources is further authorized to do the following:

(1) investigate the child support payment records of employees and applicants to determine compliance with court-ordered child support obligations;

- (2) provide information on employees and applicants to the appropriate Cook County, City of Chicago, and State of Illinois governmental entities, to the extent allowed by law, to assist those offices in enforcement of child support obligations;
- (3) provide the names and business addresses of employees to persons seeking to enforce court-ordered child support orders and child support withholding notices, and their legal representatives, to the extent allowed by law, on the condition that such information be used solely for the purpose of assisting in child support enforcement; provided that the names and identifying information of persons seeking to enforce child support orders shall be deemed confidential; and
- (4) promulgate regulations relating to the operation of this section.

WHEREAS, implementing fee based parking at the Cook County Courthouse Facilities will provide a revenue resource that will not only assist in deficit reduction but will help offset the costs of the parking facilities; and

WHEREAS, fees should be charged to any individual or employee entering utilizing the Cook County Courthouse Facility parking garages on a daily basis in an amount no less than \$4.75 a day; and

WHEREAS, monthly passes should be made available that could be applied for monthly use at any one of the Cook County Courthouse Facility parking garages for a fee of no less than \$65.00; and

WHEREAS, any individual acting as a juror, law enforcement personnel on official business, a voter participating in an early voting site, or witness under subpoena from the Cook County State's Attorney or Cook County Public Defender, and handicapped persons and disabled veterans is are exempt from having to pay a fee to park in any Cook County Courthouse Facility.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Cook County Board of Commissioners that the Departments of Facilities Management, Purchasing and Revenue Departments implement fee based parking at the following Cook County Courthouse Facility parking garages: Criminal Courts Complex (26th Street); Bridgeview Courthouse; Skokie Courthouse; Maywood Courthouse; Markham Courthouse and the Rolling Meadows Courthouse; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Cook County Board of Commissioners that the Departments of Facilities Management, Purchasing and Revenue shall work together to implement the fee based parking, and to exempt jurors, law enforcement personnel on official business or witnesses under subpoena from the Cook County State's Attorney or Cook County Public Defender, and handicapped persons and disabled veterans from having to pay the fee, within 6 months of the effective date of this Resolution inclusive of any applicable tax other than parking taxes imposed by Cook County; and



Re: Conflict Bar Attorney Program

Dear Chairman Daley:

I have prepared this letter in response to your letter of September 21, 2012, and inquiries received from certain members of the Committee on Finance at the meeting of September 10, 2012. These inquiries concern the attributes of the conflict bar attorney program at juvenile court, including the qualifications of the attorneys, the application and appointment processes, compensation arrangements and the court's review process for fee petitions.

Created in 1995, the Circuit Court of Cook County's Juvenile Justice and Child Protection Department is made up of two distinct divisions, both dedicated to provide for the care, guidance and general welfare of minors and to serve the best interests of the community. Each division operates under the auspices of a Presiding Judge. The Juvenile Justice Division hears cases involving delinquent minors under 17 years of age and all 17 year olds charged with misdemeanor offenses. Its 13 judges hear cases in 13 courtrooms on the ground floor of the old Juvenile Center in Chicago (east building, 1100 South Hamilton Street), as well as in four courtrooms used on a part-time basis in four municipal districts. The Child Protection Division hears cases involving abused, neglected and dependent minors, as well as private guardianship, and termination of parental rights. Its 15 judges hear cases in 12 courtrooms located on the ground floor and concourse level of the new Juvenile Center in Chicago (west building, 2245 West Ogden Avenue).

The Illinois Juvenile Court Act of 1987 provides that indigent parties respondent in both juvenile justice (delinquency) and child abuse, neglect or dependency cases have a right to court appointed counsel. In Cook County, representation for delinquency cases is usually provided by the Law Office of the Cook County Public Defender ("Public Defender"). For cases involving child abuse, neglect or dependency, representation is usually provided by the Public Defender or by the Circuit Court's Office of the Public Guardian ("Public Guardian").

In some cases, a conflict of interest arises that prevents the Office of the Public Defender or the Office of the Public Guardian from representing a party. When this occurs, judges must appoint private attorneys, known as bar attorneys, to provide representation. Bar attorneys are appointed more frequently in child abuse, neglect and dependency cases than in delinquency cases. This is because those cases can involve several children and other adult family members who may have had a history with Juvenile Court which results in a conflict of interest. In such conflict cases, bar attorneys usually represent parents; however, judges may also appoint them to represent children in whose interest the proceeding is brought.

For many years Cook County paid substantial fees to private bar attorneys for the representation of minors and indigent parents in the Child Protection Division. In response, in April 2011, the Public Defender opened a Multiple Defendant Unit ("MUD Unit") to help curb these costs. The MUD Unit will complete its first full year in operation in 2012. Located in the Public Defender's Delinquency Division office at the Juvenile Center, the unit's eight staff currently have a caseload of about 500 Child Protection Division cases. Due to the relatively small number of conflict cases in the Juvenile Justice Division, the MUD Unit is not involved in delinquency cases.

While progress in realizing fee cost reductions has been slow due to the delayed financial effects of the MUD Unit appointments, early results have been encouraging. Total Child Protection Division fees for 2012 are expected to decline about fifteen percent, or about \$400,000 from the average costs incurred over the previous three years, about \$2.9 million per year.

As you requested, I have attached two reports of payments to bar attorneys to date in fiscal 2012 from the court's AS-400 database, one report for the Juvenile Justice Division and one for the Child Protection Division. Please note that the totals for each report are slightly different than the totals reflected in the October 2, 2012 agenda for the Committee on Finance. This is due to timing differences in data input.

Bar Panel Program Administration

The bar attorneys for Juvenile Justice Division and Child Protection Division cases are a qualified, select group of attorneys chosen to serve on the Juvenile Court Bar Panel. The Chicago Bar Association ("CBA") administers the Juvenile Court Bar Panel. Attorneys who wish to be eligible for appointment as bar attorneys must apply to the panel through the CBA. The CBA accepts applications from attorneys licensed to practice in Illinois. To apply, an attorney must complete a written application, which outlines his or her experience and credentials. While membership in the CBA is not required, the attorney must have experience in child abuse, neglect, dependency and delinquency cases. In addition, the attorney must have practiced for at least five years. The attorney submits the written application to the CBA along with proof of malpractice insurance and a copy of the attorney's ARDC card.

Once an attorney has submitted an application, the CBA committee in charge of the program reviews the application and decides whether or not to accept the application. Currently, the CBA has approved approximately 100 attorneys to participate in the program.

Attorneys remain in the bar panel program until they resign or until they are removed. There is no ongoing review process by the CBA; however, the presiding judge of the Child Protection Division periodically surveys the judges regarding bar attorney performance. The presiding judges may remove an attorney from the bar program in response to internal or external concerns.

Assignment of Cases

The CBA assigns the days on which bar attorneys appear in juvenile court on a rotation basis with each bar attorney receiving a bar day approximately every three months. Only one bar attorney is assigned to court on a given day. In order to receive appointments that day, the attorney is expected to be in court from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Whenever the Public Defender or Public Guardian identifies a conflict of interest with a potential client, the bar attorney is called to provide representation. In the Child Protection Division, the judge hearing the case enters an order transferring the case to the Presiding Judge for appointment of the attorney. The Presiding Judge enters an order appointing the bar attorney and the case is transferred back to the original courtroom. In the Juvenile Justice Division, the judge hearing the cases enters the order appointing the bar attorney.

There are two exceptions to these procedures. The first involves the MUD Unit. Since April 2011, all cases involving a conflict with an indigent parent in the Child Protection Division have been referred to the MUD Unit to determine if the unit may provide representation. Because of the manner in which the Public Defender was structured prior to the MUD Unit, e.g. there was no segregation between the attorneys in the office, the MUD unit may still have cases where a conflict exists. In these cases, bar attorneys receive the appointment. The second exception is when a bar attorney currently represents a client on a case from a past appointment and the client has another child. In the Child Protection Division, each child is identifiable with a specific case but cases are consolidated by family. Thus if a bar attorney represents a mother on one child's case and that mother has a new child, the same bar attorney will be appointed to both cases.

Representation in a Hypothetical Child Protection Division Case

Upon appointment as an attorney for a parent or Guardian Ad Litem for a minor, the bar attorney is expected to represent the client at all court hearings until the appointment is vacated, the case closes, the client ceases to be a party to the case, or the attorney withdraws. Child Protection Division cases may last until a child reaches age 21. Currently approximately 33 percent of foster children in Illinois are aged 16 or older.

The following is a hypothetical case (including reference to the applicable statutes) outlining how a child may remain a ward of the court for an extended period of time:

1993: An event occurs that results in the court's involvement with the child. For example, in February 1993, a child is born to a drug addicted mother. The identity of the child's father is not known. Hospital toxicology tests show drugs in the child's system. The hospital contacts the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services ("DCFS") and DCFS determines that this child is mother's fourth born with drugs in his system. DCFS then takes protective custody of the child.

- Within 48 hours of protective custody, the court must begin a temporary custody hearing. The court makes the necessary legal findings and temporary custody is granted to DCFS and the child is placed in foster care. [Juvenile Court Act (705 ILCS 405/2-9)].
- Within 90 days of the service of a summons on all parties, the court must begin the trial to determine if the child has been abused or neglected. However, the parties may waive the 90 day requirement. About one-half of all new cases go to trial within approximately seven months. In this case, the court finds that the child has been neglected. [705 ILCS 405/2-14].
- Within 30 days of the trial (unless the parties waive the requirement) the court must conduct a hearing to determine if the parents are fit, willing, and able to care for the child. Over 50 percent of all cases have this hearing within 30 days. The court finds the parent unable to care for the child and appoints DCFS as legal guardian. [705 ILCS 405/2-21].

1994–1996: The court begins to conduct hearings to determine the long term goal for the child. These hearings must be conducted at least two times a year. [705 ILCS 405/2-28]. In setting the goal, the court looks first to returning the child home to a parent, then to having the child adopted, and then to having the child placed under the guardianship of a private person. The least desirable goal is for the child to remain in foster care until adulthood. Of children who leave foster care to a permanent placement (parents, adoptive parents, legal guardian) 50 percent leave the system within three years, two months. No permanent placement is identified for this particular child.

1997–2008: The court continues to hear motions in the case and to conduct twice yearly permanency hearings. No permanent placement is identified and the court sets a goal of independence for the child. In 2008, the child has his 15th birthday.

2009–2012: The court continues to hear motions in the case and to conduct twice yearly permanency hearings. Prior to the child's 19th birthday (the date on which the child's case would automatically close under the Juvenile Court Act) the child's attorney files a motion to extend wardship. [705 ILCS 405/2-31]. The court concurs and extends wardship.

2013–2014: The court continues to hear motions in the case and to conduct twice yearly permanency hearings. In February 2014, the child, now in college, turns 21 and the court closes the child's case.

Compensation Arrangements

Bar attorneys serving clients in both the Juvenile Justice Division and the Child Protection Division are compensated based on the number of hours that they devote to a case. Pursuant to Illinois Supreme Court Rule 299, Compensation for Attorneys Appointed to Represent Indigent Parties, bar attorneys receive \$50 per hour for time spent out of court and \$75 per hour for time spent in court. These fees are not subject to the limits that the Cook County Board of Commissioners established for Special State's Attorneys.

In order to receive compensation, bar attorneys present a petition for fees to the judge hearing the case. Assistant State's Attorneys are present at these hearings for these petitions and may object to all or part of the fee petition. The judge enters an order on the petition, and the bar attorney



submits that order along with a copy of the petition to the Clerk of the County Board to be included on the agenda for the Finance Committee's consideration. Before adding the order and petition to the agenda, the Clerk's Office forwards the material to the Office of the Chief Judge for review and approval. The Chief Judge's Office then reviews the submission for accuracy and enters the petition in an AS-400 system database. Upon approval by this office, the fee order is stamped "Audit Complete" and is returned to the Clerk's Office for processing.

Pursuant to General Order No. 26 issued by the Chief Judge and an order issued by the Presiding Judge of the Child Protection Division in 2005, attorneys must present their fee petitions to the appropriate trial judge within six months after the attorney performs a service or incurs a cost or 60 days after the case closes, whichever comes earlier. The purpose of the orders was to limit attorneys to current fees to aid in the judges' review and to minimize billing errors. These requirements have resulted in an increase in the number of pay orders appearing on the Finance Committee agenda, although on average, the payment amounts for each order are much smaller than they were in the past. Overall, and as noted previously, there has been a decline in the amount of fees paid since implementation of the MUD unit.
